# **Divisions**

**Warm up**: This class is available all throughout the day at any level. This will not be a judged class but will have a set course. This course will consist of stadium fences. Standard class rules apply.

Entry Fee: \$35

No ribbons awarded for this class

1. **Starter**: This class is designed to be an introductory level for horses and riders. Jumps will not exceed 2'. This course will include a mixture of Stadium and cross-country fences. The course will not include banks. There will be an option for water crossing, or an option to avoid water.

Awards: 1st-6th

2. **Jumper Derby 2'**: This class will be a course of stadium fences only. Jumps will not exceed 2'. This course will not include banks or water.

Entry Fee: \$55

Awards: 1st-6th

3. **Beginner Novice**: This course will include a mixture of stadium and cross-country fences. This course will include banks and water. Jumps will not exceed 2'7".

Entry Fee: \$55

Awards: 1st-6th

4. **Jumper Derby 2'7":** This class will be a course of stadium fences only. Jumps will not exceed 2'7". This class will not include banks or water.

Entry Fee: \$55

Awards: 1st-6th

5. **Novice**: This course will include a mixture of stadium and cross-country fences. This course will include banks and water and a ditch. Jumps will not exceed 2'11".

Entry Fee: \$55

Awards: 1st-6th

6. **Jumper Derby 2'11":** This class will be a course of stadium fences only. Jumps will not exceed 2'11". This class will not include banks, water or ditch.

Entry Fee: \$55

Awards: 1st-6th

7. **\$100 Fox Run Mini Prix**: A course of stadium like jumps will be set with jumps not exceeding 3'3". This course will include banks and a liver pool. This course will not include water. Winner of this class with receive \$100 cash! \*Must have 4 entries for winning payback\*

### **Rules**

- \*Standard Class rules apply. 45 seconds to cross the start line after signal (bell, or whistle). Classes will be scored on faults and time. 4 faults per rail. 20 faults for a refusal. Three refusals and elimination.
- \*Divisions can be cross entered.
- \*One entry per horse and rider combination, per class.
- \*All Riders are required to wear approved helmets while mounted.
- \*Safety vests are required.
- \*Warm-up rounds are unlimited and run as an open-card. Please just let the in-gate steward know you are riding a warm-up round.
- \*All riders are required to sign the riding release and return with completed entry.
- \*Everyone loves having a barn buddy/groom tag along. We need to have waivers signed for everyone on the property, even if they will not be riding. If you know that your mom, dad, or barn friend will be tagging along please fill out a second waiver and submit it with your entry.

## **Dress code**

Braiding and show attire is not required although it is open to those who would like to show off the extent of their equestrian wardrobe!

#### **Cancellations and Scratches**

In the event of a cancellation competitors will be notified no less than 48 hours in advance via the email provided on entry. Entry fees will be reimbursed. In the event of a scratch, Entries will be reimbursed if the scratch is made 1 week in advance of the event. Scratches made after close date will forfeit their entry.

1. Inherent Risks and Assumption of Risk. The undersigned acknowledges there are inherent risks associated with equine activities such as described below, and hereby expressly assumes all risks associated with participating in such activities. The inherent risks include, but are not limited to the propensity of equines to behave in ways such as, running, bucking, biting, kicking, shying, stumbling, rearing, falling or stepping on, that may result in an injury, harm or death to persons on or around them; the unpredictability of equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions; collisions with other animals; the limited availability of emergency medical care; and the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the animal or not acting within such participant's ability.

User acknowledges that horses, by their very nature are unpredictable and subject to animal whim. User assumes all risks in connection therewith, and expressly waives any claims for any injury or loss arising therefrom. User agrees to abide by and follow Manager's rules and regulations which, shall be posted and/or available from time to time. User further acknowledges that the behavior of any animal is contingent to some extent upon the ability of User. User assumes all risks therefor and warrants a full and fair disclosure of Rider's abilities has been made to Manager.

User expressly releases Management from any and all claims for personal injury or property damage, even if caused by negligence (if allowed by the laws of this State) by Management or its representatives, agents or employees.

#### WARNING

You are advised that there are inherent risks, including the risk of serious injury or death, while engaging in equine activities. By engaging in equine activities and in accordance with the terms of this agreement you hereby assume all risks of injury or death.

- 2. User agrees to assume any and all risks involved in or arising out of User's use of any equipment or livestock pertaining to the rental of horses or taking of riding lessons, the use of any arena on the premises of Management and for purposes of taking riding lessons either on the premises or lessons given off the premises by Management personnel.
- 3. USER (OR USER'S PARENT OR GUARDIAN IF USER IS A MINOR) AGREES TO HOLD HARMLESS, INDEMNIFY AND DEFEND MANAGEMENT AGAINST ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, CAUSES OF ACTION, DAMAGES, JUDGMENTS, ORDERS, COSTS OR EXPENSES, INCLUDING ATTORNEY'S FEES, WHICH MAY IN ANY WAY ARISE FROM OR BE IN ANY WAY CONNECTED WITH USER'S USE OF OR PRESENCE UPON THE PROPERTY OF MANAGEMENT AND THE FACILITIES LOCATED THEREON. In the event User is a minor, the parent or guardian shall further indemnify, defend and hold Management harmless from any such claims by said minor child.
- 4. In the event User is using User's own horse, or a horse(s) not owned by Management, User warrants said horse(s) shall be free from infection, contagious or transmittable diseases. Management reserves the right to refuse access or use of any horse upon the premises that does not appear to Management to be in good health, or is deemed dangerous or undesirable. **SEE BACK-TURN OVER**

5. Any action brought under this agreement shall be brought within one (1) year of the incident or
accident giving rise to said claim.
6. User agrees to waive the protection of any applicable statutes in this jurisdiction whose purpose,
substance and/or effect is to provide that a general release shall not extend to claims, material or otherwise, which the person giving the release does not know or suspect to exist at the time of executing said release.
7. Any visitor attending along side the rider will not hold liable David Chugg, Fox Run Farm, or Courtney LaBarbera in the event a guest is injured during their visit. Horses are inherently dangerous and the visitor assumes all responsibility for any actions.
